THE ELDER SHELTER, ACTION INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES

JOSEPHINE HOUSE, CUSCO, PERU

Josephine House is an orphanage for children from dysfunctional families, special needs children and abandoned children. Some children are able to return to their family; some are adopted and some remain at Josephine House. The workers do Bible study activities with the children, assist in Vacation Bible School at the local church, and teach the children to crochet. Josephine House exist at three (3) different levels:

1. A Peruvian Institution that prohibits discrimination on hiring. Hence, they have no doctrinal statement.
2. A U.S. Board comprised of Evangelical believers of churches that subscribe to the Westminster Confessions of Faith.
3. In Cusco, they are connected to a local Presbyterian Church. They recently celebrated the in adjuration of a new building, and will hopefully be moving into it by the end of March, 2016.

AMBER STARK, LIFE IMPACT MINISTRIES, SLOVAKIA

Amber runs and oversees the "Good Book Oasis" in Slovakia. It is a respite (Oasis) for missionaries and pastors who need rest, refreshment, relaxation and encouragement.
